The Abilities & Characteristics of Angels

Created - Finite/Limited but Eternal

- Colossians 1:16 & Psalm 148:2-6

Righteous - Perfectly Obedient

- Fallen Angels (Rev 12:7–12, Eze 28:15–17, Isa 14:12–15)

Strong/Mighty/Powerful

- Destroys 185,000 Assyrians (2 Chron 32:21, 2 Kings 19:35)

Intimidating

- Genesis 3:24 , 1 Chronicles 21:15–16 , 2 Kings 6:17

Awe Inspiring

- Revelation 19:10 & Revelation 22:8–9

Sometimes Seen & Sometimes Unseen

- 1 Chronicles 21:15–16 & 2 Kings 6:16-17

Numerous - 2 Kings 6:17 & Deuteronomy 33:2 “the ten thousands”

Appear as Humans - Genesis 19:1, Judges 13:3–22

Appear Supernaturally

- Genesis 31:11; Ex13:21-22, 14:19-20; Matthew 2:13, 19-20; Matthew 28:2-7, John 20:12-13; Ascension - Acts 1:10-11

Seen by Animals - Numbers 22:22–38 Balaam’s Donkey

Disappear Supernaturally - Judges 6:21, Judges 13:3–22

Fly - Isaiah 6:2 & Hebrews 1:7

Feel Emotions - Joy, Praise

- Luke 2:13–14 (ESV) “a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, ‘Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!’”

Refuse Worship & Redirect All Worship to God - As Fellow Servants

- Revelation 19:9–10 & Revelation 22:8–9

Withholds their name when requested to “honor” the angel - Judges 13:3–22 name is withheld as it is “wonderful”

Communicate their name

- Gabriel - Daniel 8 & 9; Gabriel and other Angels Appear to Mary, Joseph, Zechariah, and the Shepherds (Luke 1:11-20, Luke 1:26-38, Luke 2:8-15, Matthew 1:20-25, Matthew 2:19)
- Michael - Daniel 10 & 12, Jude 9, Revelation 12

Provide - Supernaturally

- Genesis 22:11–15 - a Ram for Burnt Offering

Eat - Angels in Sodom & Gomorrah - Genesis 19:3

Instead of Eating, Guides Sacrifice towards God in Worship - Judges 13:3–22 - a sacrifice for the Lord

Consume Food with Spontaneous Fire

- Judges 6:21 to Gideon, consumed food with fire from rock

Cause Blindness - in Sodom & Gomorrah - Genesis 19:11

Cause Muteness - Gabriel to Zechariah (Luke 1:11-20)

Kill - Supernaturally

- 2Chron32:21, 2 Kings 19:35, 2 Sam24:16-17, Acts 12:22-23
- John’s Vision on Patmos (the book of Revelation)

Bring Forgiveness from God - Zechariah 3:4, Isaiah 6:6-7

Help & Minister

- Minister to Jesus After Satan’s Temptations (Matthew 4:11)

Angels from Beginning to End

Matthew 24:29–31 “Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then will appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.” (ESV)

The Abilities & Characteristics of Angels

Created - Finite/Limited but Eternal

- Colossians 1:16 “For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.”
- Psalm 148:2-6 - “For he commanded and they were created. And he established them forever and ever; he gave a decree, and it shall not pass away.”

Righteous - Perfectly Obedient

- Fallen/Faithless Angels (Revelation 12:7–12, Ezekiel 28:15–17, Isaiah 14:12–15)

Strong/Mighty/Powerful

- God Destroys 185,000 Assyrians (2 Chronicles 32:21, 2 Kings 19:35)

Intimidating

- Genesis 3:24 “He drove out the man, and at the east of the garden of Eden he placed the cherubim and a flaming sword that turned every way to guard the way to the tree of life.”
- Prepared to destroy Jerusalem - 1 Chronicles 21:15–16 “And God sent the angel to Jerusalem to destroy it, but as he was about to destroy it, the LORD saw, and he relented from the calamity. And he said to the angel who was working destruction, “It is enough; now stay your hand.” And the angel of the LORD was standing by the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite. [16] And David lifted his eyes and saw the angel of the LORD standing between earth and heaven, and in his hand a drawn sword stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders, clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.” (ESV)

Awe Inspiring

Sometimes Seen & Sometimes Unseen

- Prepared to destroy Jerusalem - 1 Chronicles 21:15–16 “And God sent the angel to Jerusalem to destroy it, but as he was about to destroy it, the LORD saw, and he relented from the calamity. And he said to the angel who was working destruction, “It is enough; now stay your hand.” And the angel of the LORD was standing by the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite. [16] And David lifted his eyes and saw the angel of

the LORD standing between earth and heaven, and in his hand a drawn sword stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders, clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.” (ESV)

Numerous

- Elisha Asks for His Servant to See the Lord’s Army of Horses and Chariots (2 Kings 6:17)
- Deuteronomy 33:2 “The LORD came from Sinai ... he came from the ten thousands of holy ones, with flaming fire at his right hand.”

Appear as Humans

- Angels in Sodom & Gomorrah - Genesis 19:1 “The two angels came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them and bowed himself with his face to the earth”
- Judges 13:3–22 Manoah and his wife believe the angel to be a “man of God”

Appear Supernaturally

- Genesis 31:11 to Jacob in a Dream
- The Lord & the Angel of God Lead Israel by Pillar of Cloud and Fire (Ex13:21-22, 14:19-20)
- To Joseph in a dream to go & return from Egypt (Matthew 2:13, 19-20)
- Angels Appear at Jesus’ Tomb Upon His Resurrection (Matthew 28:2-7, John 20:12-13)
- Angels at Jesus’ Ascension (Acts 1:10-11)

Seen by Animals

Numbers 22:22–38 to Balaam, Balaam’s Donkey Speaks

Disappear Supernaturally

- Judges 6:21 to Gideon, vanished

- Judges 13:3–22 angel departs from Manoah in the flame of the fire from the altar that consumed a sacrifice for the Lord

Fly

- Isaiah 6:2 “Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.”
- Hebrews 1:7 “Of the angels he says, ‘He makes his angels winds, and his ministers a flame of fire.’”

Move - Supernaturally

- The Lord & the Angel of God Lead Israel by Pillar of Cloud and Fire (Ex13:21-22, 14:19-20)
- Living Creatures - Ezekiel 1, 3, 10, 11

Interact with People & Physical Objects with Touch

- Angels in Sodom & Gomorrah - Genesis 19:10 “But the men reached out their hands and brought Lot into the house with them and shut the door.”
- Genesis 19:16 “But he lingered. So the men seized him and his wife and his two daughters by the hand, the LORD being merciful to him, and they brought him out and set him outside the city.”
- Isaiah 6:6–7 “Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. [7] And he touched my mouth and said: “Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for.” (ESV)
- 1 Kings 19:5-8 - Food to Elijah when he was about to die
- And he lay down and slept under a broom tree. And behold, an angel touched him and said to him, “Arise and eat.” (ESV)
- An Angel of the Lord delivers Peter from prison (Acts 12:7-10)

Refuse Worship & Redirect All Worship to God - As Fellow Servants

- Revelation 19:9–10 “Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God.” For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.”

- Revelation 22:8–9 “I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me, [9] but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God.”

Withholds their name when requested to “honor” the angel

- Judges 13:3–22 Manoah asks the angel his name, but the name is withheld as it is “wonderful”

Communicate their name

- Gabriel - Daniel 8 & 9
- Gabriel and other Angels Appear to Mary, Joseph, Zechariah, and the Shepherds (Luke 1:11-20, Luke 1:26-38, Luke 2:8-15, Matthew 1:20-25, Matthew 2:19)
- Michael - Daniel 10 & 12, Jude 9, Revelation 12

Provide - Supernaturally

Genesis 22:11–15 to Abraham - Provide a Ram for Burnt Offering

Eat

- Angels in Sodom & Gomorrah - Genesis 19:3 “he made them a feast and baked unleavened bread, and they ate.”

Instead of Eating, Guides Sacrifice towards God in Worship

- Judges 13:3–22 angel departs from Manoah in the flame of the fire from the altar that consumed a sacrifice for the Lord

Consume Food with Spontaneous Fire

- Judges 6:21 to Gideon, consumed food with fire from rock

Cause Blindness

Angels in Sodom & Gomorrah - Genesis 19:11 “And they struck with blindness the men who were at the entrance of the house, both small and great, so that they wore themselves out groping for the door.”

Cause Muteness

Gabriel to Zechariah (Luke 1:11-20)

[11] All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.” (ESV)
