Jesus' Death

Crucifixion

- Romans 4:25 “who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification.”
- John 15:13 “Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.”
- 1 John 3:16 “By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us”

Our Spiritual Death

Dead In Sin

Ephesians 2:1–3 “And you were dead in the trespasses and sins [2] in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—[3] among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.” (ESV)

Our Death to Self

Repentance

Romans 6:6–8 “We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. [7] For one who has died has been set free from sin. [8] Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.”

Jesus' Life

Resurrection = Life After Death

Romans 6:9–10 “We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. [10] For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God.”

1 Corinthians 15:17 “And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins.”

Our Spiritual Life

Salvation

Romans 10:9, “If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”

Romans 6:11–14 “So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. [12] Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. [13] Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. [14] For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace. (ESV)
