7 Warning Signs

of False Prophets, Teachers & Pastors

Jeremiah 23:1 “Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture!’ declares the LORD.”

1) L_____ Others’ Faith thru Lesser Things

2 Timothy 2:16–18 “But avoid irreverent babble, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness, and their talk will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, who have swerved from the truth, saying that the resurrection has already happened. They are upsetting the faith of some.”

2) Lead People Away from God

2 Corinthians 11:3–4 “But I am afraid that as the serpent deceived Eve by his cunning, your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ. For if someone comes and proclaims another Jesus than the one we proclaimed, or if you receive a different spirit from the one you received, or if you accept a different gospel from the one you accepted, you put up with it readily enough.”

3) **L_____ When Satan Attacks- “A Hired Hand”**

John 10:11–13 “I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. He who is a hired hand and not a shepherd, who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees, and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. He flees because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep.”

1) Lessen Others’ Faith thru Lesser Things

2) Lead People Away from God
