Suffering, Promise, Punishment, and Glory: 2 Thessalonians 1

1) Our faith grows hand in hand with our love for others.

“We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing.” *Verse 3*

2) Our faith can be contagious. Be an example!

“Therefore we ourselves boast about you in the churches of God for your steadfastness and faith in all your persecutions and in the afflictions that you are enduring.” *Verse 4*

3) Our endured suffering is evidence for our salvation.

”This is evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering” *Verse 5*

4) God’s justice gives us comfort and peace.

“since indeed God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us” *Verses 6-7*

5) God’s justice will be revealed in the form of hell.

”when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might” *Verses 7-9*

6) We will marvel and He will be glorified.

”when he comes on that day to be glorified in his saints, and to be marveled at among all who have believed, because our testimony to you was believed.” *Verse 10*
